Timely, accurate and complete information provided through SCEIS will empower decision-makers to *improve the way government works* for the citizens of South Carolina.



- Sandbox client is ready for testing
- Support Package 12 has been applied
- Contract Contract
- Testing to Begin May 5th
- Plan to complete testing May 30th

- Must be integrated with Service Pack testing

- Formal Kickoff May 22nd
- Beeline resources to start May12th

- Treasurer and Comptroller General's Office have been engaged





- Master data configuration design is not best practice

- Content of the master data elements within the Cost Accounting and Funds Management modules is required

Must be completed by June 30th





- Staffing request has been made to handle the parallel work streams
- Resources requested:
 - 40 State Employees (25 FTE's and 15 Agency staff)
 - I5 SAP Functional and Technical Beeline resources
- Staffing requests are being made to the agencies
 - SCEIS will pay the resources salary and fringes
 - Agency will receive a fully trained SAP super user for their rollout
 - Requests are being made for all modules (FI, MM, and HR/PY)
