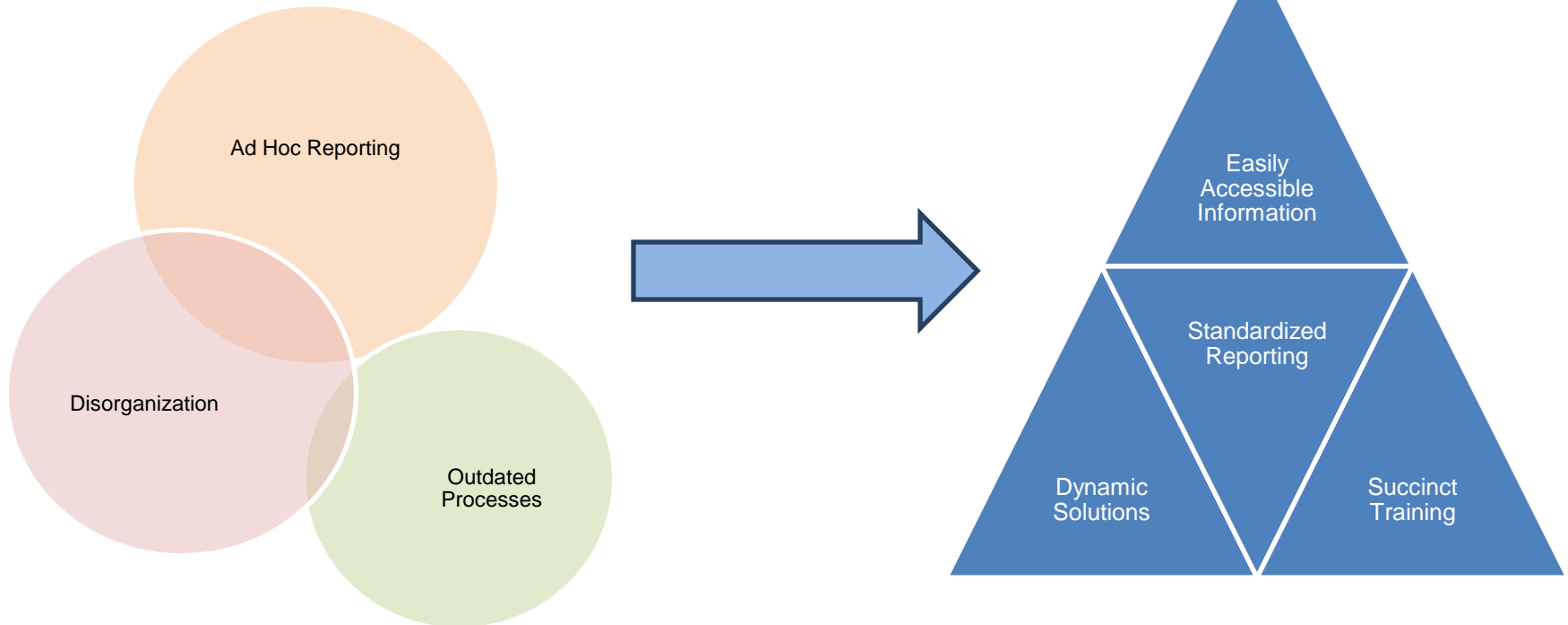
EIM: Success and More Success

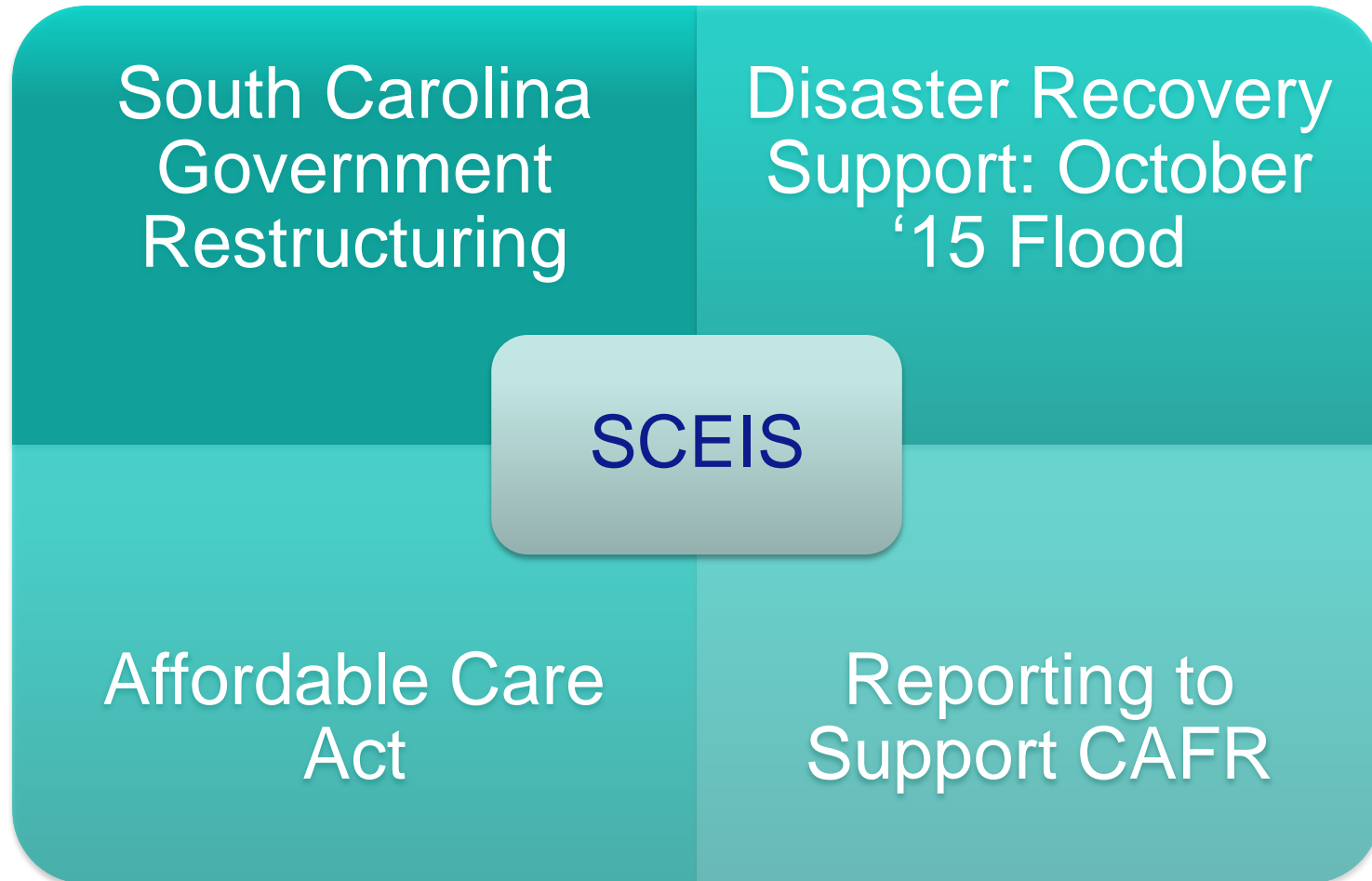

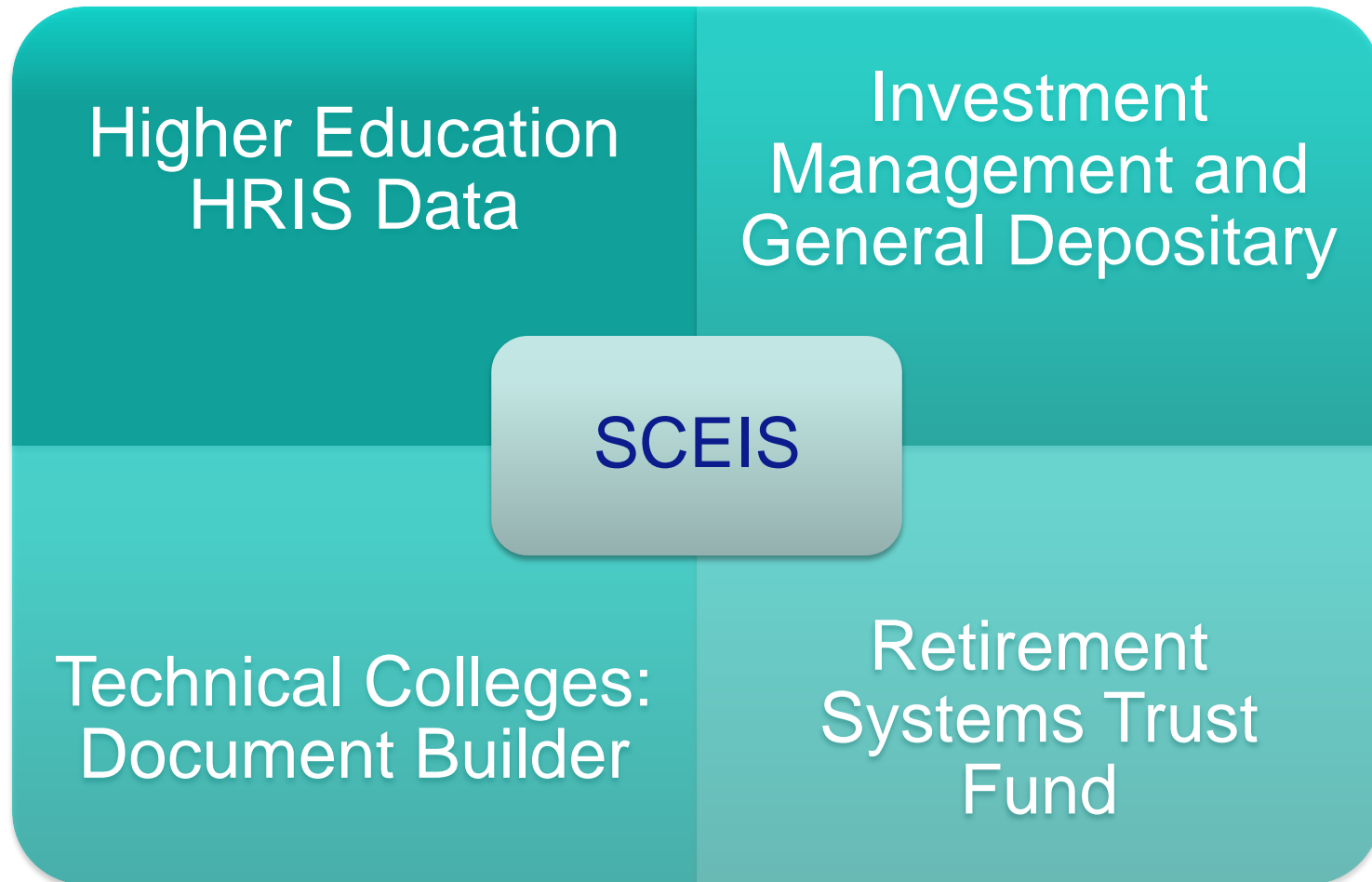

Opportunities and Challenges



The SC Enterprise Information System and the SCEIS Team continue to manage **transition** through **competing needs** of each State agency and a centralized enterprise information system.

Opportunities for **continued innovation and functional development** are ever present. Many goals set for 2016 will involve more **complex integration of systems and development work.**

In CY15, the SCEIS Team recognized an **average of 20 new or recurring projects on a monthly basis.** We project this trend to **continue in CY16.**

Opportunities and Challenge

The upcoming year will require a **high level of statewide partnership** as we standardize functionality for key functions such as real estate, fleet, and work order management.

Addressing established requirements and timelines while updating security measures, managing system maintenance, supporting users, and installing critical upgrades will present many **challenges with system and personnel resources**.
