Description

The MML100V online course teaches you how to extend and maintain a Material Master Record in the SCEIS system.

In MML100V, users will:

- Gain knowledge of key terms and concepts pertaining to Material Master Records (MMR).
- Gain knowledge of roles and responsibilities of CMMDTs and AMMLs.
- Learn the process for creating a Material Master Record.
- Learn how to extend a Material Master Record.
- Learn how to maintain a Material Master Record.


