

**Subject:** April 2020 Severe Weather Event Internal Order

**Audience:** Finance Directors

Wednesday, April 15, 2020, the Comptroller General's Office distributed an email message to finance directors stating:

“The Governor has issued Executive Order No. 2020-24 declaring a state of emergency for South Carolina in response to the severe weather event that occurred over the course of April 12 – 13. This executive order confirms the Governor's prior activation of the South Carolina Emergency Operations Plan in response to COVID-19 and directs that the Plan be further placed into effect for this severe weather event.

In order to collect the costs associated with this event, a statewide disaster internal order # has been created in SCEIS: 98000019 – **APRIL 2020 SEVERE WEATHER EVENT**. Any state agencies incurring expenses related to this event should begin using this internal order # to start tracking costs.”
